Neuropsychological and Neuropsychiatric assessment

We will pay a fee of up to £600.00 for an eligible assessment. To qualify, the assessment must be preauthorised by us. If not preauthorised, the reimbursement limit of £100.00 for psychologists and £180.00 for psychiatrists will apply, and we will shortfall the claim. The payment we make is to include all preparation, report writing, travel and any other administrative costs.

Audiological assessment

We will pay a fee of up to £150.00 for an eligible audiological assessment which is inclusive of all diagnostic tests and should not be charged as individual items.
